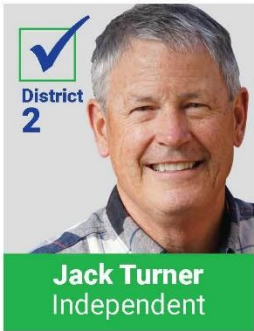


You deserve a choice.

Our Petition Plan (approved by San Juan Basin Health):

1. **Volunteers** will wear personal protective equipment to maximize safety for all.
2. **Free protective gloves** will be offered to all voters.
3. **Souvenir pens**, untouched by other persons will be offered to each voter. They are yours to keep.
4. **Sign Petition** – A volunteer will give you a clipboard with a petition to sign. Voters must provide:
 - Signature,
 - Printed Name,
 - Residence address (including street name and number) where you are registered to vote. Do not use a post office box.
